CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. SCT. 8586/(825)/VE-3.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments issued in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Apprenticeship Adviser in the Maharashtra Educational Service, Group B, in the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training under the Higher and Technical Education Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Apprenticeship Adviser in the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training (Recruitment) Rule, 1998.

2. In these rules unless the context requires otherwise,—

- (a) " Board " means the Board of Technical Examination, Maharashtra State, Mumbai.
- (b) " Commission " means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;
- (c) " Degree " means a degree of a statutory University;
- (d) " Government " means the Government of Maharashtra;
- (e) " Recognised Institute " means an institute recognised by Government.

3. Appointment to the post of Assistant Apprenticeship Adviser in the Maharashtra Educational Service, Group B, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the posts of Assistant Engineering Superintendent, Lecturer in Engineering, Full time Teacher, Junior Surveyor *cum* Junior Apprenticeship Adviser, Group Instructor, Foreman or Assistant Superintendent, having not less than three years regular service in that post; and possessing a degree or diploma in Engineering or Technology; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates, who—

(i) unless already in the service of the Government are not more than thirty years of age; and

(ii) (a) possess a Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering or Electrical Engineering at least in the second class; or

(b) possess a diploma in Mechanical Engineering or Electrical Engineering at least in the second class awarded by the Board or its equivalent and have passed Sections A and B of the A.M.I.E. (India); and

(iii) possess, after acquiring the basic academic qualification mentioned sub-clause (ii) above, practical experience in a position of responsibility in a workshop or experience in the field of training or teaching experience

8. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if in the opinion of the Government the exigencies of service so required, Government may after consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointment to the posts of Assistant Apprenticeship Adviser in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules for recruitment by nomination.

9. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.
