No. SAO 8576/4037(75)/TE-2B, In exercise  
of the powers conferred by the proviso to article  
of the Constitution of India and in supersession  
of all existing rules, orders or instruments made  
in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is he  
pleased to make the following rules regulating  
recruitment to the posts of Deputy Apprenticeship  
Adviser (senior), Deputy Director of Vocational  
Education and Training-cum-Deputy Apprenticeship  
Adviser (senior) in the Maharashtra Educational  
Service, (Class-I), in the Directorate of  
Vocational Education and Training of the Govern  
of Maharashtra, namely :-

1.(i) These rules may be called the Deputy  
Apprenticeship Adviser (senior), and Deputy  
Director of Vocational Education and Training-  
cum-Deputy Apprenticeship Adviser (senior) in the  
Directorate of Vocational Education and Training  
(Recruitment) Rules, 1986.

(ii) These rules shall be deemed to have come  
into force with effect from the 3rd day of July  
1985.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires  
otherwise -

(a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public  
Service Commission;

(b) "degree" means a degree of a statutory  
University;

(c) "diploma" means a diploma awarded by the Board of Technical Examinations, Maharashtra State, or its equivalent thereto;

(d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

(e) "recognised institution" means an institution recognised by Government.

2. Appointment to the posts of Deputy Apprenticeship Adviser (senior), Deputy Director Vocational Education and Training-cum-Deputy Apprenticeship Adviser (senior) in the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training shall be made either --

(A) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of selection from amongst the persons holding the posts in the Maharashtra Educational Service, class-I, mentioned in Schedule 'A' appended to these rules, possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed in sub-clause (ii) of clause (B) of this rule prescribed for appointment by nomination; or

(B) by nomination from amongst the candidates who--

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 40 years of age;

(ii) possess--

(a) a Master's degree in Engineering or Technology or a second class degree in Engineering or Technology; or

(b) a second class diploma in Engineering or Technology or an equivalent qualification and have passed Sections 'A' and 'B' of the Associate Membership Examination of the Institute of Engineers (India); and



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(c) professional experience gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in paragraphs (a) or (b) of sub-clause (ii) above in an Engineering or Technology concern preferably engaged in production; or experience of teaching in an Engineering College or Higher Polytechnic or Technological and teaching experience as aforesaid, for not less than five years or

(d) (i) a second class diploma in Engineering or Technology; and

(ii) professional or teaching experience mentioned in paragraph (c) of clause (ii) above for not less than ten years gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (d) above, out of which at least five years should have been in the capacity of Principal, Industrial Training Institute or an equivalent or higher post;

Provided that -

(i) in the case of candidates possessing Master's degree, the period spent in acquiring the degree, but not exceeding two years may be counted towards the period of experience prescribed above;

(ii) the age-limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both

(iii) if candidates with the prescribed period of experience are not available in sufficient numbers, those with experience of a shorter period may also be considered;



(iv) preference may be given to candidates having experience in administering the Apprenticeship Training Scheme or Craftsman Training Scheme.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (ii) of clause (B) of rule 3, if at any stage of selection, the Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite higher basic academic qualifications or experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes including Scheduled Castes converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes, then the Commission may, in the matter of such selection relax the requirement in respect of the class in the degree or diploma or the period of experience set out therein and select suitable candidates belonging to such Castes or Tribes.

5. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or by nomination, shall be required to pass the examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, these examinations.

7. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

8. Appointments to the posts by promotion and nomination shall be in the ratio of 50:50.

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9. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules; if in the opinion of Government the exigencies of service so require, Government may, after consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointments to the posts of Deputy Apprenticeship Adviser (senior) as well as Deputy Director of Vocational Education and Training-cum-Deputy Apprenticeship Adviser (senior), in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules for recruitment by nomination.
