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CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. SCT. 8580/170446/(10)TE-2(B).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments issued in this behalf and in force in the State of Maharashtra, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Registrar in the Maharashtra Educational Service, Class-II, in the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training under the Education and Employment Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Registrar in the Maharashtra Educational Service, Class-II, in the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training (Recruitment) Rules, 1985.
2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise—
 - (a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "degree" means degree of a Statutory University;
 - (c) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training of the Government;
 - (d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.
3. Appointment to the post of Registrar in the Directorate shall be made either—
 - (a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding the post of Superintendent in the office and educational institution under the Directorate who have completed not less than three years' service in Class-III post; or
 - (b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who
 - (i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than thirty five years of age;

- (ii) possess a degree at least in Second Class or a Post-Graduate degree; and
- (iii) possess experience preferably in a Supervisory capacity for not less than five years in a Government Office or an Educational Institution, ^{sub-clause (ii) of this sub-rule;} acquired after acquiring the basic academic qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of this sub-rule;

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendations of the Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both;

Provided further that, preference may be given to candidates possessing exceptional qualifications or experience or both;

Provided also that, if candidates with the prescribed period of experience are not available in sufficient number, those with experience of a shorter period may also be considered.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (b) of rule 3, if at any stage of selection, the Commission is of the opinion that at sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite higher academic qualifications or experience are not available to fill up the basic academic vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Castes converts to Buddhism, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes, then the Commission may, in the matter of such selection, relax the requirement in respect of class in academic qualifications or the period of experience or both set out therein, and select suitable candidates belonging to such Castes or Tribes.

5. Appointments to the posts by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50:50.

6. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

7. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or by nomination, shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi and Departmental Examinations according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing these examinations.

* 8. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

9. Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 5, if in the opinion of the Government at the exigencies of services so require, the Government may, after consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointments to the posts of Registrar, in relaxation of the percentage prescribed in these rules for recruitment by promotion and nomination.
