CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. SCT. 8580/170446/(10)TE-2(B).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments issued in this behalf and in force in the State of Maharashtra, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Registrar in the Maharashtra Educational Service, Class-II, in the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training under the Education and Employment Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Registrar in the Maharashtra Educational Service, Class-II, in the Directorate of Vocational Education and Training (Recruitment) Rules, 1985.
